



## 2024 FAA Reauthorization – Key Developments Impacting Emerging Aviation

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After months of negotiations, the President Biden signed into law the Securing Growth and Robust Leadership in American Aviation Act after months of negotiations and numerous last-minute extensions. The Act funds the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) through Fiscal Year (FY) 2028 with over \$105 billion in appropriations.

- Title III: Aviation Safety Improvements
- Title IV: Aerospace Workforce

- Title VIII: General Aviation
- Title IX: New Entrants and Aerospace Innovation
- Title X: Research and Development
- Title XI: Miscellaneous
